1	Nature of the tasks:
<p>The SNE will actively collaborate in the tasks of the unit which are to support the development and implementation of European policies and related activities in the area of Intelligent Transport Systems and in particular the implementation of the C-ITS Strategy COM 2016/766 in Europe. More specifically, he/she will within the team:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contribute to the development and implementation of an EU-wide C-ITS Credential Management System (EU CCMS) • Contribute to the concrete implementation of the EU CCMS with all public and private stakeholders involved in the large scale deployment initiatives through the C-Roads and C-ITS Platform. • Contribute to the international harmonisation and interrelations of the EU CCMS with other regions of the world • Contribute to the associated necessary processes in regard to C-ITS compliance assessment

2 Main qualifications:

a) Eligibility criteria

The following eligibility criteria are to be fulfilled by the candidate in order to be seconded to the Commission. Consequently, the candidate who does not fulfil one of them will be automatically eliminated from the selection process.

- Professional experience: at least three years' experience in administrative, legal, scientific, technical, advisory or supervisory functions which can be regarded as equivalent to those of function groups AD;
- Seniority: at least one year by your employer, that is having worked for an eligible employer (as described in Art. 1 of the SNE decision) on a permanent or contract basis for at least 12 months before the secondment;
- Linguistic skills: thorough knowledge of one of the EU languages and a satisfactory knowledge of another EU language to the extent necessary for the performance of the duties. An SNE from a non-member country must produce evidence of a thorough knowledge of one EU language necessary for the performance of his duties.

b) Selection criteria

- diploma:

Relevant university education.

- professional experience:

- Relevant experience in ICT/transport domain as well as with issues related to ICT and/or transport innovation;
- Understanding of, and experience in ICT and/or transport related technologies would represent a valuable asset;
- Understanding of, and experience of C-ITS related issues would represent a valuable asset, in particular in relation to C-ITS security;
- Good general knowledge of the challenges of the European transport policy;
- Previous experience with Commission's industrial projects and initiatives would be an asset;
- Preference will be given to a dynamic, well-organised and highly motivated candidate with strong problem-solving, analytical and coordination skills as well as very good drafting and communication skills and good judgement.

- language(s) necessary for the performance of duties:

The SNE must have an excellent knowledge of one EU language and must have a satisfactory knowledge of a second one. A very good command of English (including drafting) is essential.

3 Submission of applications and selection procedure

Candidates should send their application according to the **Europass CV format** (<http://europass.cedefop.europa.eu/en/documents/curriculum-vitae>) in English, French or German **only to the Permanent Representation / Diplomatic Mission to the EU of their country**, which will forward the applications to the competent services of the Commission within the deadline fixed by the latter. **Not respecting this procedure or deadlines will automatically invalidate the application.**

Candidates are required not to add other documents (such as copy of passport, copy of degrees or certificate of professional experience, etc). If necessary, these will be requested at a later stage.

Candidates will be informed of the follow-up of their application by the unit concerned.

4	Conditions of the secondment
<p>The secondment will be governed by the Commission Decision C(2008)6866 of 12/11/2008 laying down rules on the secondment to the Commission of national experts and national experts in professional training (SNE Decision). This decision is available on http://ec.europa.eu/civil_service/job/sne/index_en.htm.</p> <p>The SNE will remain employed and remunerated by his/her employer during the secondment. He/she will equally remain covered by the national social security.</p> <p>Unless for cost-free SNEs, allowances may be granted by the Commission to SNEs fulfilling the conditions provided for in Art. 17 of the SNE decision.</p> <p>During the secondment, SNEs are subject to confidentiality, loyalty and absence of conflict of interest obligations, as provided for in Art. 6 and 7 of the SNE Decision.</p> <p>If any document is inexact, incomplete or missing, the secondment may be cancelled.</p>	

5	Processing of personal data
<p>The selection, secondment and termination of the secondment of a national expert requires the Commission (the competent services of DG HR, DG BUDG, PMO and the DG concerned) to process personal data concerning the person to be seconded, under the responsibility of the Head of Unit of DG HR.B4. The data processing is subject to the SNE Decision as well as the Regulation (EC) No 45/2001 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2000 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Community institutions and bodies and on the free movement of such data.</p> <p>Data is kept by the competent services for 10 years after the secondment (2 years for not selected or not seconded experts).</p> <p>Data subjects may exercise their right of access to data concerning them and the right to rectify such data by applying to the controller, in accordance with Article 13 of the Regulation on the processing of personal data.
